**Moment of Science**

Lynn: Svante Paabo was awarded the Nobel Prize for Physiology or Medicine for pioneering the field of paleogenomics. This has revolutionized our understanding of human evolution. It is not solely based on the morphology of skeletal remains anymore. This has been especially enlightening in the study of Neanderthal. Lynn mentioned that Paabo's father had also won a Nobel Prize and this led to some discussion of other pairs of relatives who had also won, such as the Curie's.
